We have 25 Kinder and 12 Nursery pupils. We have a different kind of situation with each child. We have poor, lonely, abandoned, neglected, wrong-parenting and helpless and abused.

- We have six (6) students who worked abroad with their mother as a domestic helper.
- One (1) special-needs child.
- Six (6) students who come from a broken home/family.
- Four (4) students who worked with their mother as public teachers.

When I observed and assessed them, I cried a lot because of the circumstances that they facing. This is a big challenge for us to trust and pray that the Lord has a best plan for each child.








Prayer Requests.
